Notes on the Data

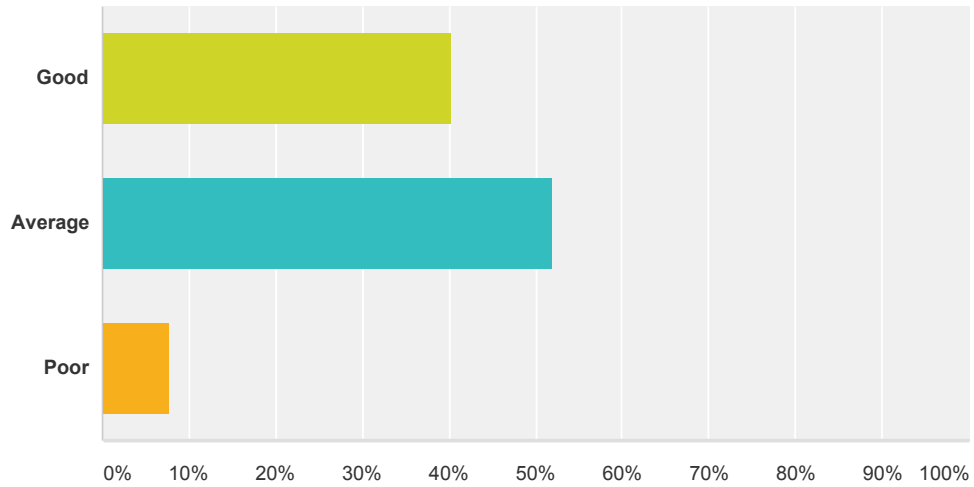
A total of 876 surveys were completed by residents of Southmead, taking on average 20 minutes each to complete a survey. That's a staggering 17,520 minutes - or over 12 days - total!

Questions 1 ("House Number & Post Code") and 39 ("Contact Details") have been removed due to confidentiality, but were answered by 740 (136 skipped) and 474 (402 skipped) residents respectively.

Included in the data is a selection of comments and quotes from local residents.

Q2 Overall how SATISFIED are you with Southmead as a place to live?

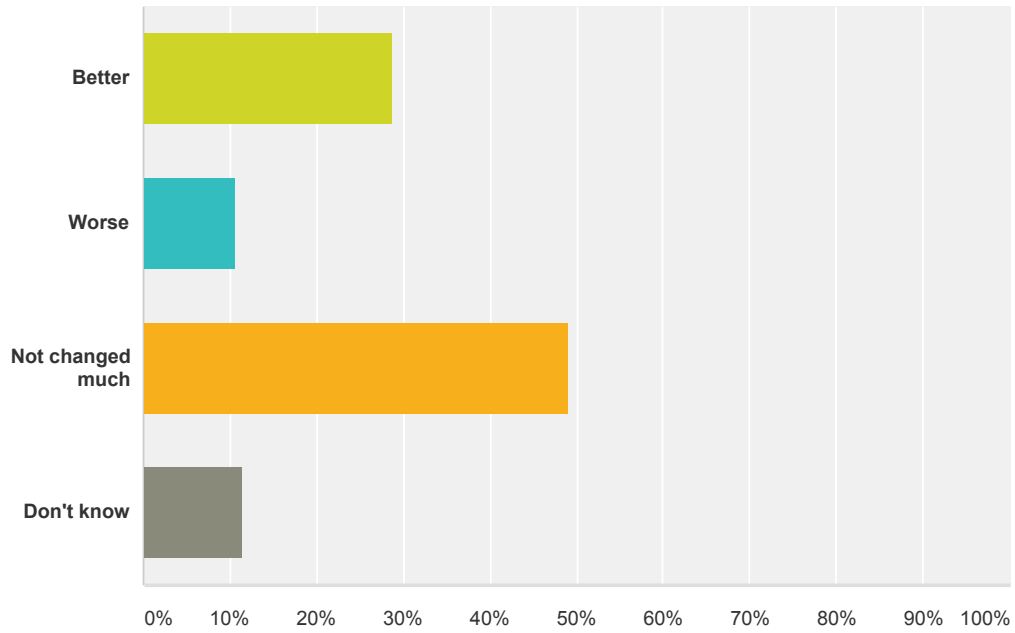

Q3 Over the last 3 years has the area got better or worse?

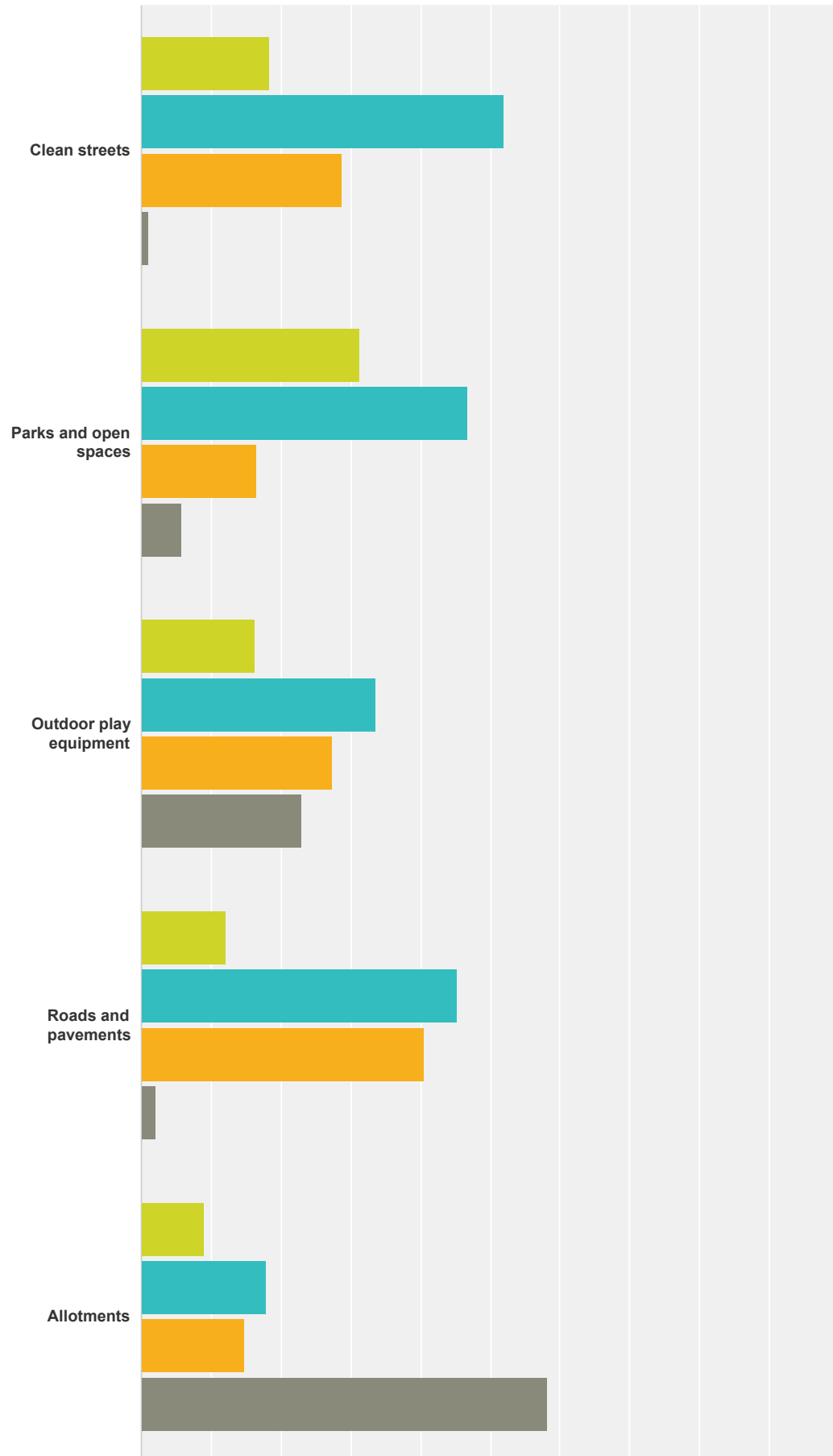

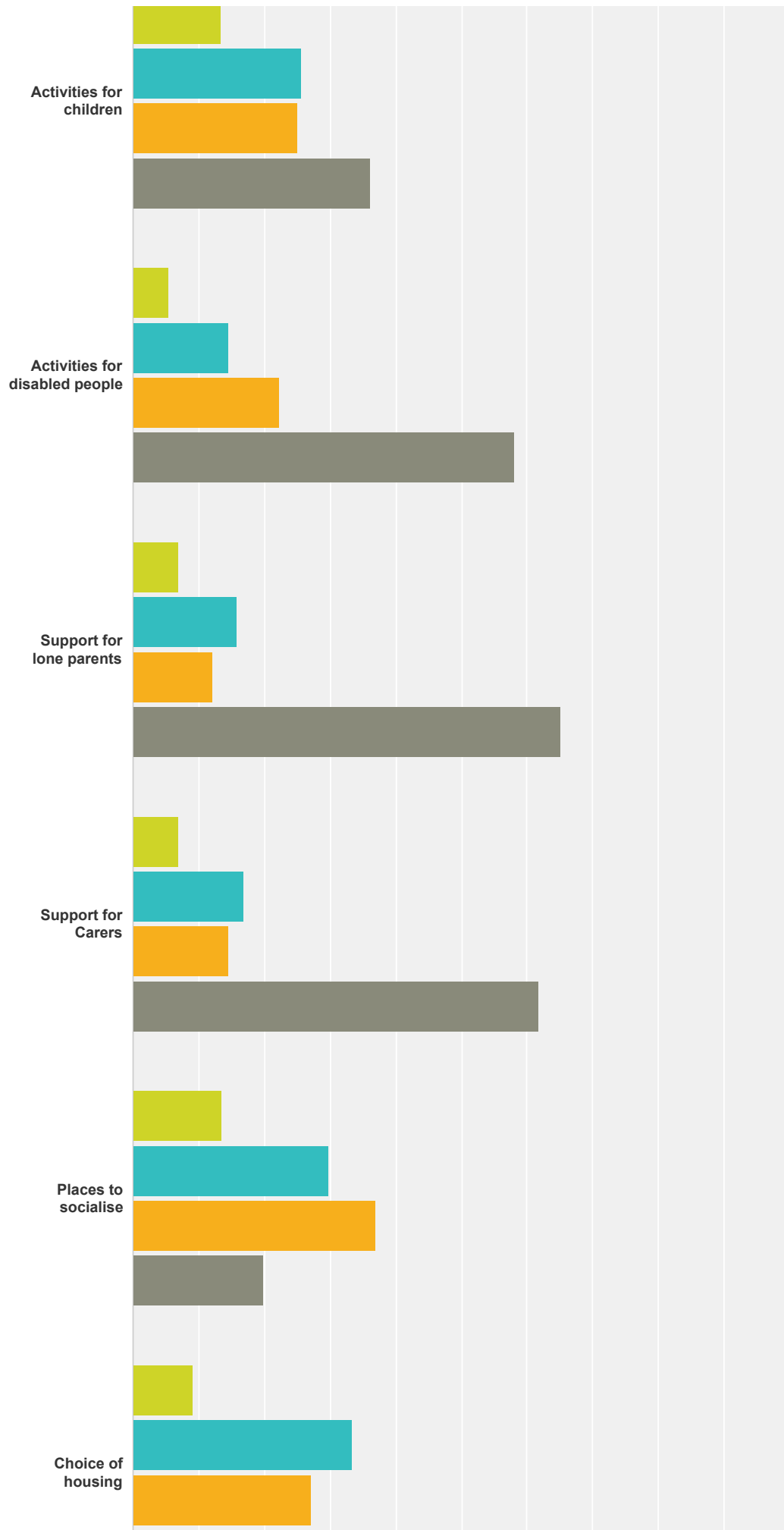
Q4 How would you rate the following in Southmead?

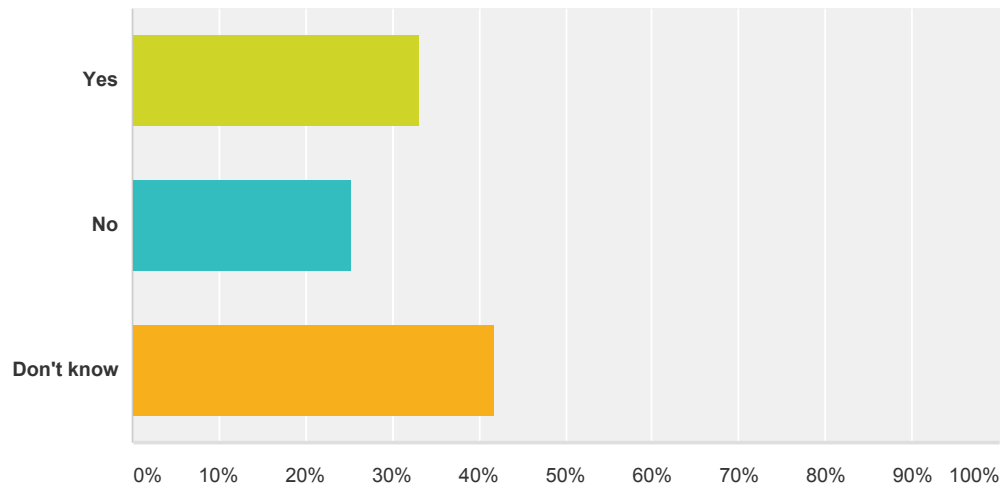

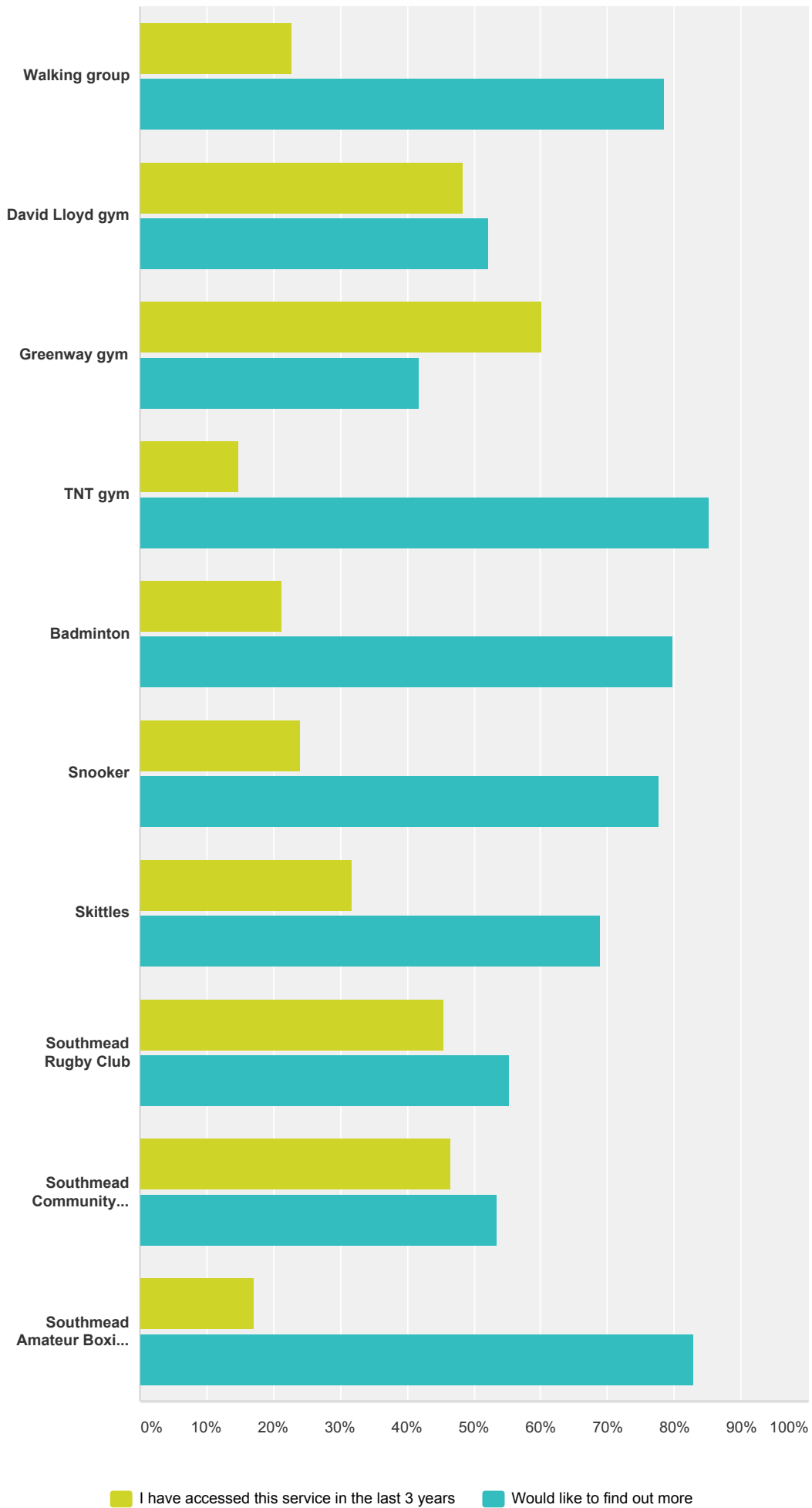

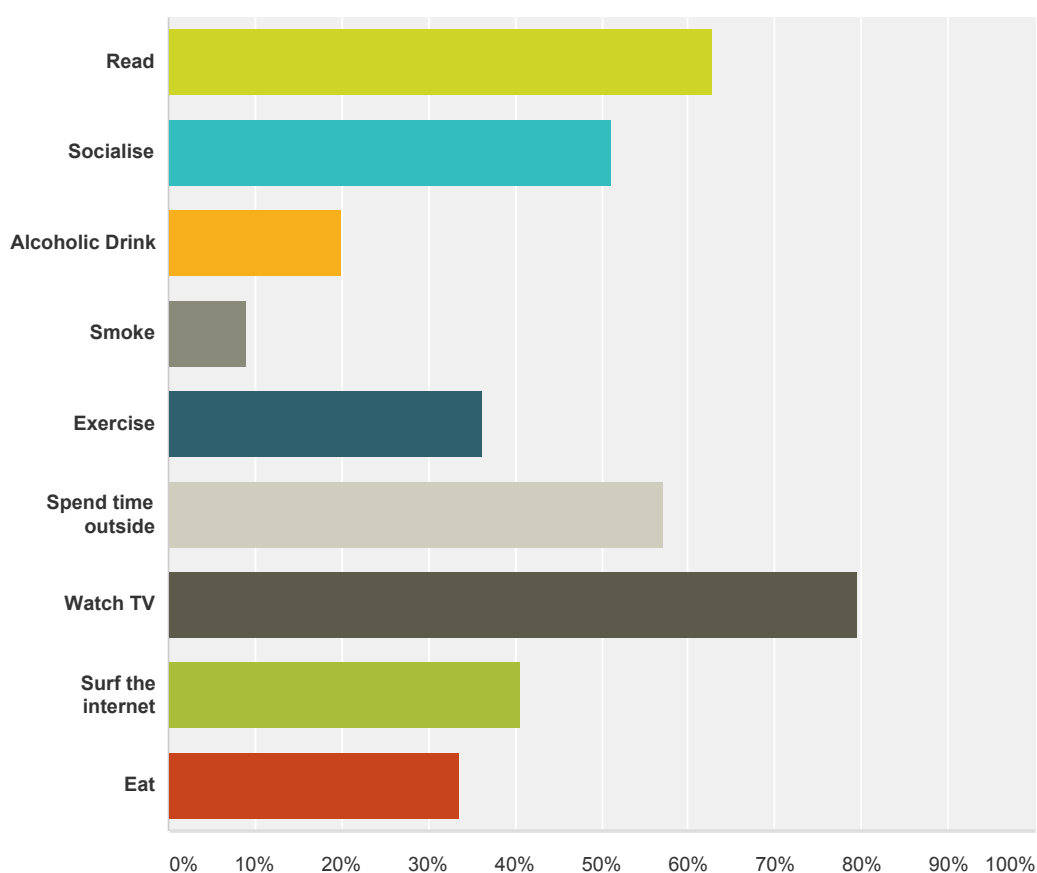

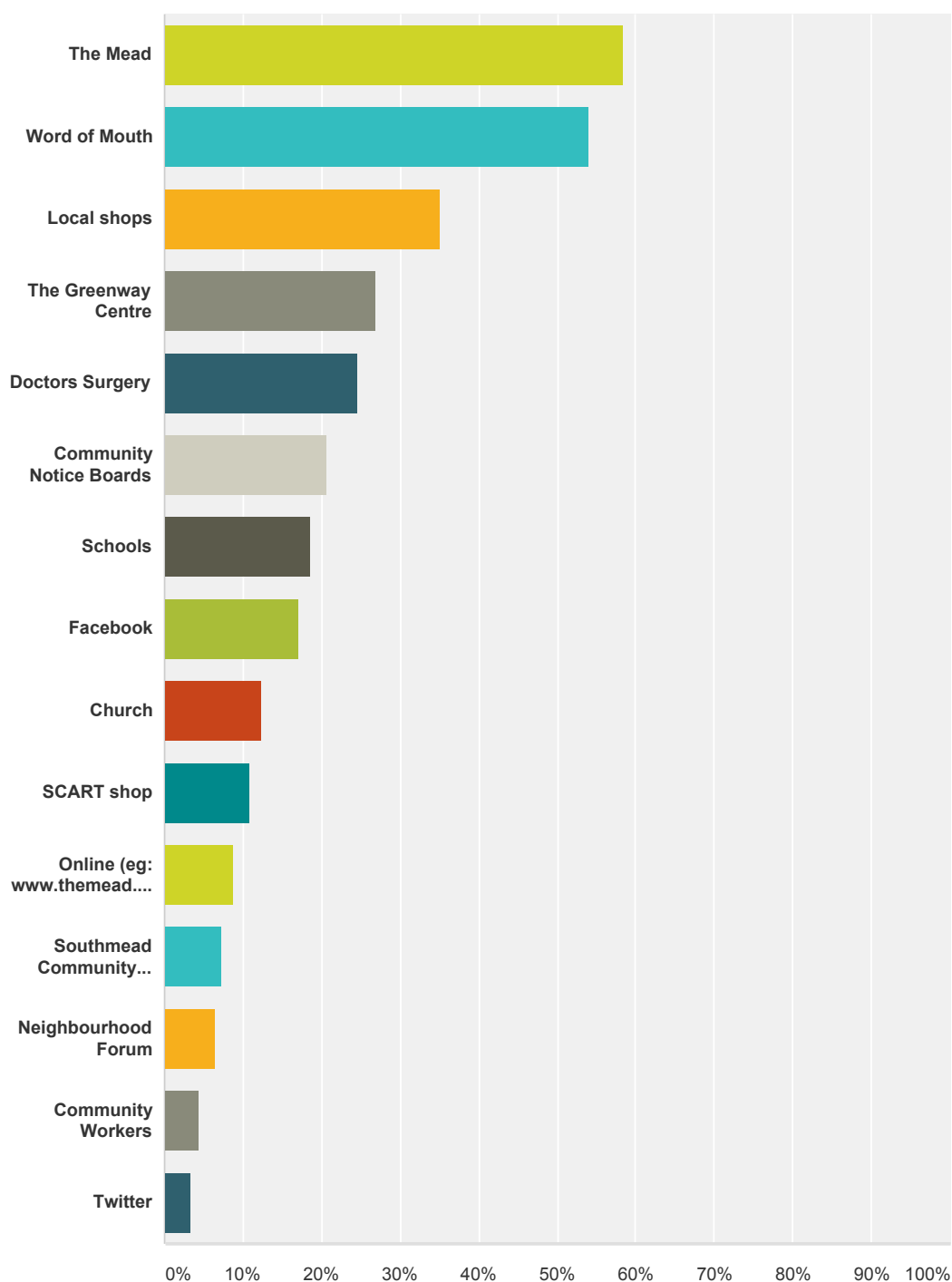

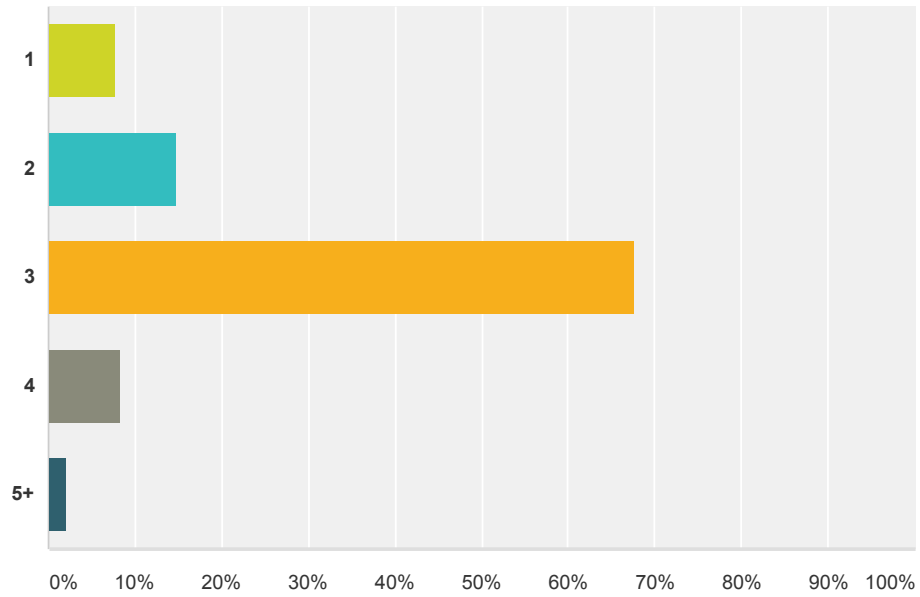

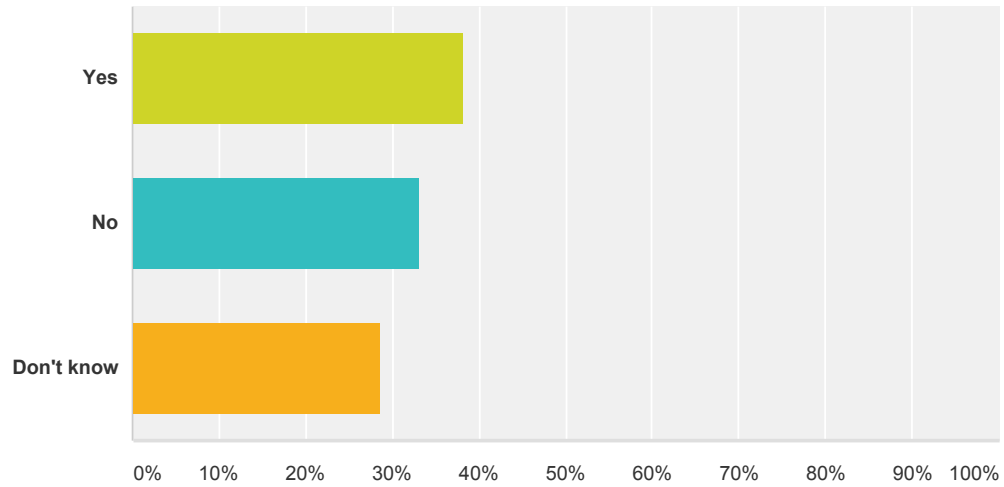

Q38 Do you volunteer?

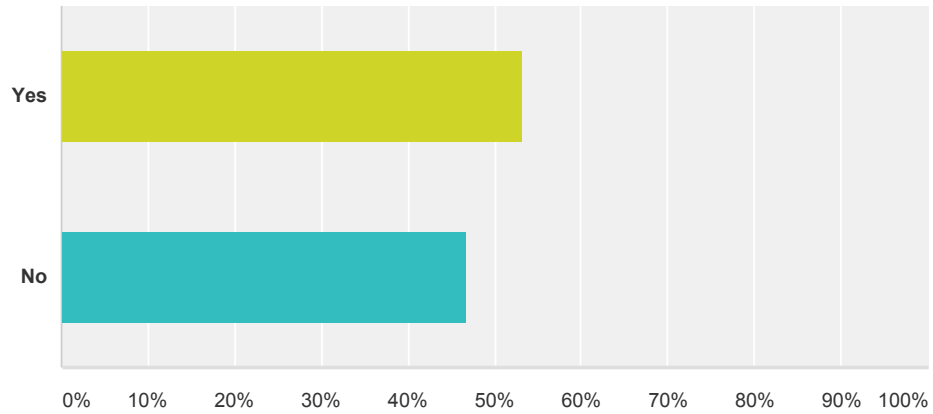

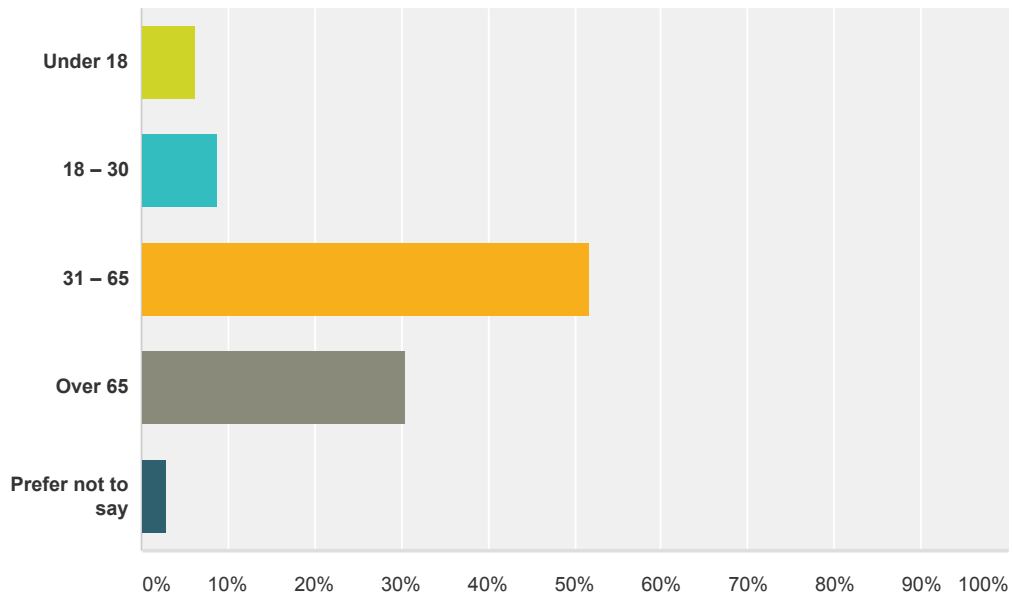

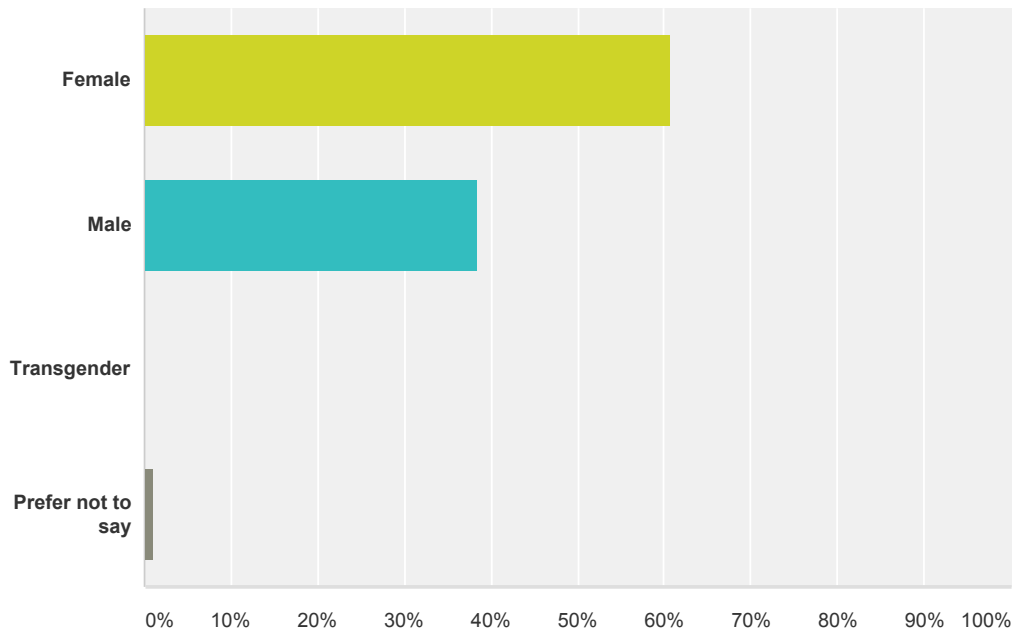

Q43 Gender

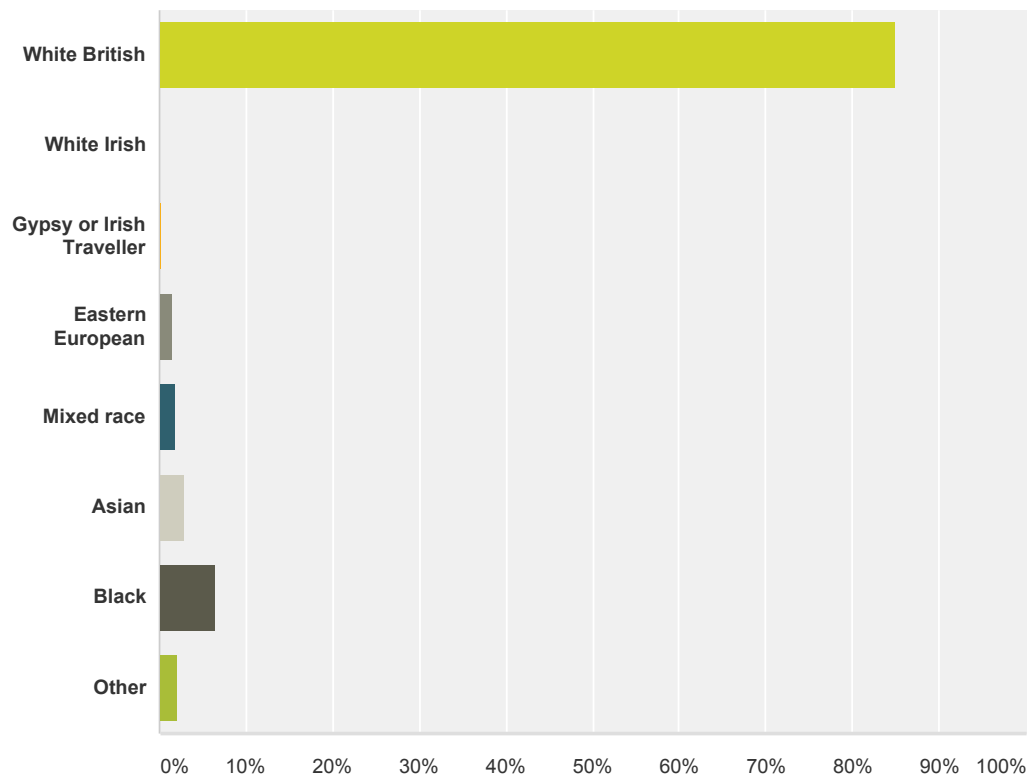

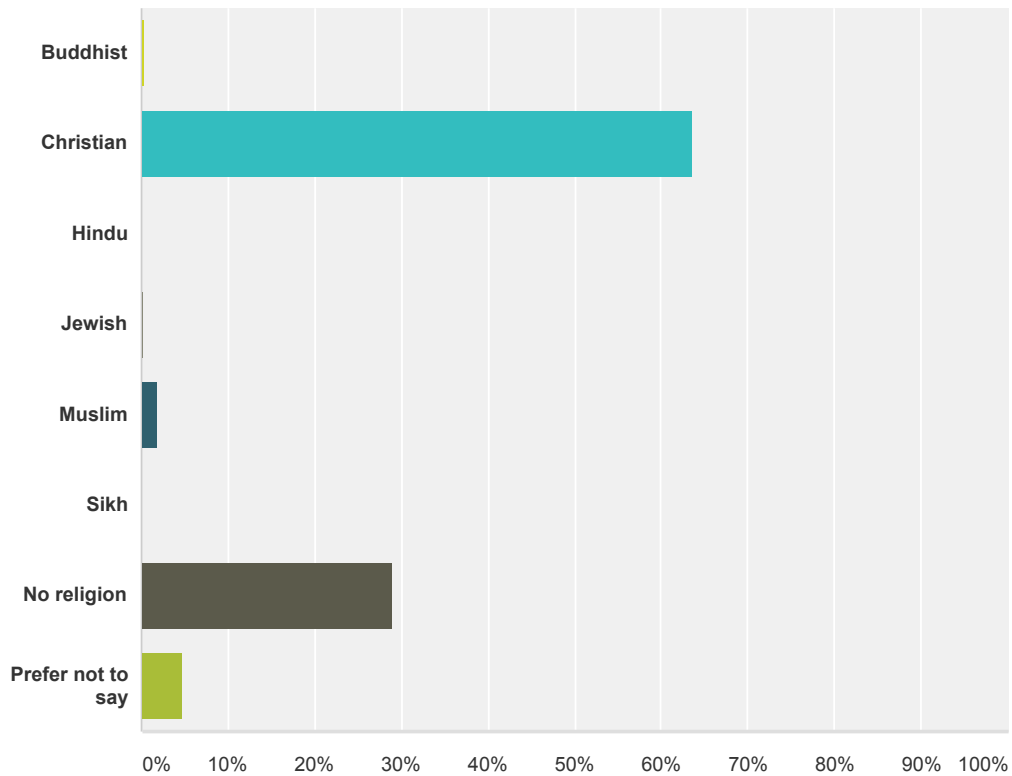

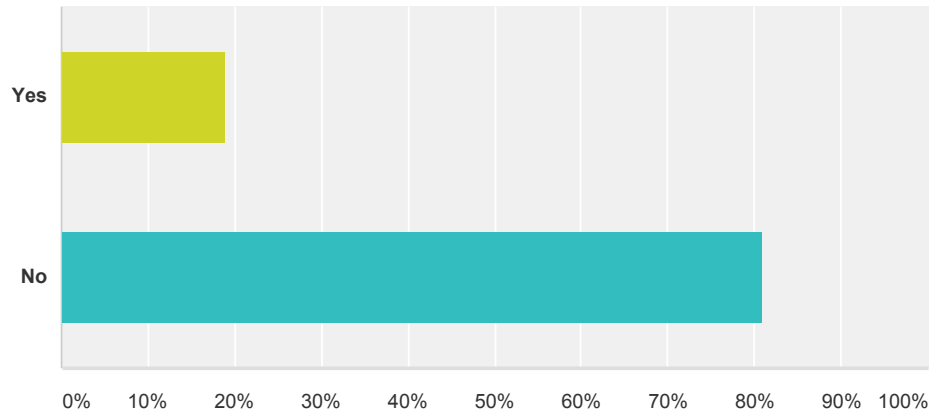

Q47 Do you consider yourself to be a disabled person?

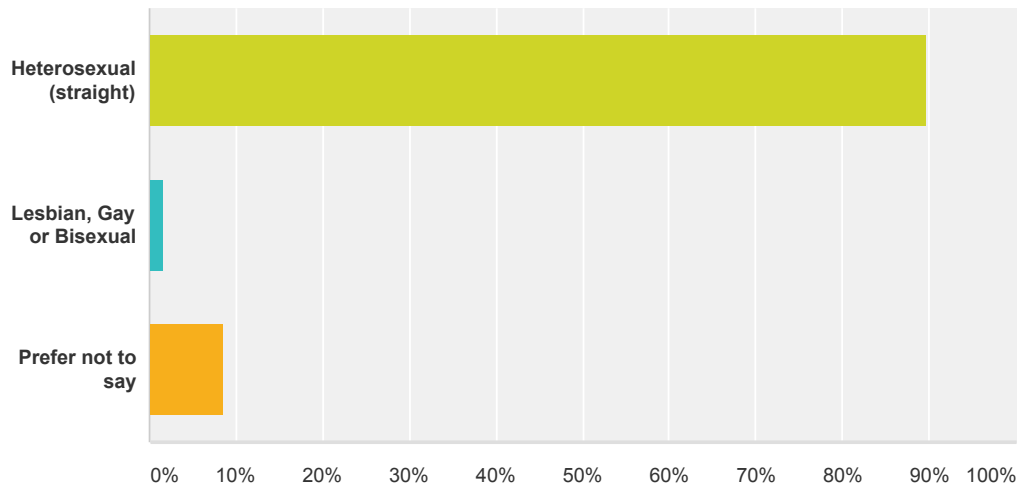
